In order to assist the Admissions Committee in its placement of students, applicants are invited to indicate their area(s) of interest in order of preference. Where the applicant is hoping to write a Thesis or Major Research Paper, he or she may also indicate a preferred advisor. The admissions committee will contact all successful applicants prior to making an offer of admission to discuss campus placement.

Each campus will be accepting approximately the same number of students. Students will be offered admission to one of the three Tri-University History program departments. The coordinating committee will make every effort to maximize each applicant's chance of admission and funding through its recommendations for campus placement. Scholarships and TA-ships will normally be held on the campus at which the student is registered.

Note to Guelph applicants: The University of Guelph now requires MA applicants to choose between a thesis-based degree and a course-based degree in their application. In the Tri-University program, a thesis-based degree consists of 4 seminar courses and a thesis (100 pages) while a course-based degree consists of 6 seminar courses and a Major Research Paper (50 pages). If you are unsure which degree to apply for, contact the Guelph graduate coordinator for help.
